Our first project was to build the inside kennel walls. We decided to construct them with concrete block up to 6 foot and finish the kennel walls with chain link. That will help us contain those silly Huskies that like to climb...

Once the interior walls were completed, we had to take a break to raise funds to continue construction. As we strategized our next fundraising endeavor, we received the most unbelievable email...

We received notification from the Petco Foundation that we had been awarded a grant (which we had applied for months ago). We couldn't believe our eyes and then we saw the amount ~ \$20,000! We almost passed out.

The check arrived in the mail on May 31st and we've already begun arranging work weekends for our volunteers. We will finally be able to finish our kennels and we can't wait to welcome our first "official" guest!

Increase in Adoption Fees

Effective June 1st, our adoption fees have been increased. This increase will be applied to all applications received on or after June 1st.

Our new adoption fees are:

- **Puppies**, 8 weeks to 6 months ~ \$275, as well as a \$200 spay/neuter deposit (which is refunded once MaPaw receives written confirmation the pup has been spayed/neutered)
- **Adults**, 6 months to 8 years ~ \$275
- **Seniors**, 9 years and up ~ Adoption fees are flexible

Foster Homes Needed

Our network of foster homes is MaPaw's greatest asset. While we wait for the construction of the kennels to be completed, our foster homes are what allow us to bring more dogs into rescue. Once the construction of the kennels is complete, we will still need our foster homes to help the dogs in rescue to settle into family life and learn their manners (housebreaking, crate training, walking on a leash, etc.). While the kennels will allow us to bring more dogs into rescue, our foster homes will help those dogs get their second chance at becoming a member of a family again.
