MaPaw Cookbook Recipe of the Month!

This month's recipe is for Goldie's Peanut Butter and Honey Canine Cookies (found on page 222):

3/4 cup flour

1 egg

1 tablespoon honey

1 teaspoon peanut butter

1/4 cup vegetable shortening

1 teaspoon baking soda

1/4 cup rolled oats

1/2 teaspoon vanilla

Heat honey and peanut butter until runny (about 20 seconds in the microwave). Mix all ingredients together and drop by 1/2 teaspoonful onto cookie sheet and bake at 350 degrees for 8 - 10 minutes. For larger treats, use a tablespoon.

We hope your pups enjoy them as much as ours do!

An Update on the Kennels

Our volunteers have been working hard and the kennels are looking amazing!

After replacing the defective electrical box, we are waiting for final approval from the inspector before the electric company "flips the switch". All of the electrical outlets have been installed and are ready for the power. We've put the heating/air conditioning unit and hot water heater in place and just need the electric to complete the installation.

The drywall has been installed on the interior walls and spackling is underway in preparation for painting. The interior flooring needs to be sealed, but that will be one of the last items to get done.

We are getting so close... We can't wait to finish the kennels and welcome our first guest!

We have 2 happy tails to share since our last newsletter update...

The first lucky pup is Rex. We were contacted about Rex after his family lost their home. Rex had been an inside dog for the first year of his life, but spent the next 6 as an outside dog on the end of a chain. When his family left their home, they made sure his chain was secure and would visit with him once a day to feed him. When we were contacted, we quickly made room for him in rescue.

Rex was missing patches of fur on his body and his foster family patiently tended to his skin issues. After months of TLC, Rex's skin looked much better, he clearly felt better and his hair started to grow back. He was becoming such a happy boy and such an integral part of their family. His foster family soon realized that the search for Rex's forever family was over and happily adopted him!

Rex was adopted on September 29th.

The other happy tail was Gage. This pup came to MaPaw at just 9 months old. He was surrendered after his family could no longer care for him. We happily welcomed this big guy into rescue. He was surprisingly low energy for such a young Husky. He wasn't with us long before he caught the eye of his new family. They had lost their two Siberian Huskies in the last year and were hurting. When Gage met his new family at a meet and greet, it was clear that they quickly developed a strong connection. Gage was adopted shortly after.

Gage was adopted on October 12th.
