MaPaw Cookbook Recipe of the Month!

In light of all of the recent treat recalls, we've decided to introduce a new feature in our monthly newsletter ~ a pup treat recipe from our cookbook.

This month's recipe is for Bar-B-Q Bones (found on page 237):

2 cups whole wheat flour
1/2 cup oatmeal
1/2 cup wheat germ
1/4 cup barbecue sauce
2 tablespoons vegetable oil
1/2 cup water

Preheat oven to 375°F. Combine dry ingredients. In a separate bowl, mix oil, water and barbecue sauce. Add to dry ingredients. Roll dough to 1/4" thick, cut with cookie cutter and place on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake for 35 minutes. Makes approximately 2-1/2 dozen.

These treats are a favorite of the pups on the Farm. We hope your pups enjoy them as much as ours do!
